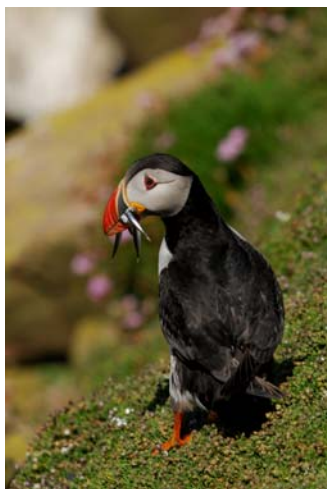

It is an event for people from all backgrounds, both expert ornithologists and armchair birdwatchers alike. The theme will be Seabirds: Life on the Edge. Learn how issues such as climate change are affecting our seabird populations and how seabirds have evolved survival techniques to live on the edge.

The venue will be the Sligo Park Hotel & Leisure Club on the edge of Sligo town. Guests will enjoy the backdrop of landscaped gardens and mature trees as well as free access to the 4 star leisure centre.
